

UK-Kerala Business Meet, 2011





UK-Kerala Business Meet, 2011





British South India Business Meet, 2012





UK-Kerala Business Meet, 2012





UK-Tamil Nadu & Puducherry Business Meet, 2013





UK-South India Business Meet, 2013





UK-Tamil Nadu & Puducherry Business Meet, 2014





UK-South India Business Meet, 2014







UK-India Healthcare Summit,2016









International Women's Day, 2018




